As part of our celebrations and learning within school we are having a **Prayer Breakfast on Monday 18**<sup>th</sup> **November.** Families and children are invited along to the school dining hall from **8.30am** for toast, tea/coffee and milk. At **9am** we will gather as a whole school community for a short prayer service led by Father Morton and our Pope Francis Faith Award pupils. All families are warmly invited to attend.

## Family Learning Open Afternoon – Wednesday 20th November 1.30-2.30pm

Parents and families are invited along to the school on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> November for a Literacy themed Open Afternoon from 1.30pm - 2.30pm.

## Wednesday 6th December ~ Parent Council Children's Christmas Disco

Our Parent Council are organising a Christmas Disco for the children in school on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> December. Tickets can be bought in school. Details will be sent home nearer the time.

## School Christmas Show ~ Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> December 9.30am & 1.15pm

Primary 1 - 3 children will perform a Nativity play with Primary 4-7 singing Christmas carols and festive songs. Tickets £3 each.

Due to the very high number of families within the school we are only able to allocate one ticket for each

**performance to each family**. Please look out for an order slip in your eldest child's bag week beginning Monday 4<sup>th</sup> December. (Families may wish to swap tickets to allow 2 family members to come to one performance.) It is anticipated that all ticket allocation will be used. If there are any spare tickets, we will let families know and draw names from a hat for any spare tickets.

## Nursery Christmas Nativity Show ~ Wednesday 11th December at 10am

The children will perform the Nativity show for families. Each family will be allocated 4 tickets costing £3 each. If there are any unallocated tickets, families may be able to purchase an extra ticket. Tickets will go on sale nearer the time. Please look out for information in the Nursery.

## Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> December ~ Nursery & School Christmas Lunch

Christmas Lunch will be served on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> December. Please look out for menus in your child's bag in late November and return them to school and Nursey with your child's lunch choice. Parents' of Primary 6 & 7 who pay for their child's lunch can do so in the usual way through ParentPay.
