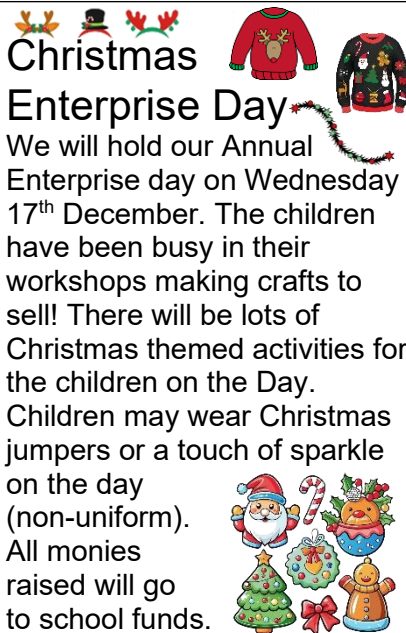
Chocolate Raffle
