Children may wear their polo shirt to school on PE days and change into their shorts. Please see the PE Timetable issued via Parent Portal.

Jewellery – Children are permitted to wear a watch and stud earrings, which should be removed for PE. Please note staff will not tape children's ears for PE. Children should not wear any other items of jewellery to school.

Home Learning - Starting in September

Home Learning activities will be issued on a monthly basis.

The skills and knowledge children develop and practise through Home Learning activities is evident in completed class work.

If there is a specific need for any child to have targeted Home Learning, an Additional Support Plan will be discussed with parents.

More information will be shared regarding Home Learning in the coming weeks with the first Home Learning Grid being issued on Monday 7th September.

Breakfast Club 8.15am each morning

- Breakfast Club has started for school children and is very popular. This is **free to all school children**. There is no need to book a place. Children should enter the school via the Lunch Hall Door where staff will supervise children and dismiss them into the yard at 8.45am
- Please note children **should not arrive for Breakfast Club before 8.15am**.

School Lunches

Primary 1-5 are all entitled to a free school lunch. Primary 6 & 7 children can order a school lunch costing £2.71. P6 & 7 pupils who are eligible for free school meals are not charged.

If children wish milk parents are asked to order this through ParentPay. (Carton of milk - 33p).

If your child has any special dietary requirements or you need help with ParentPay please contact the school office.
